Celebrating National Nutrition Week

During National Nutrition Week 2025, we observed the theme "Food Connects Us" in communities across multiple regions by bringing families together to learn about healthy eating. We organized cooking demonstrations, nutrition sessions, and provided nutrition kits to TB patients. Children and families participated in contests and activities while learning to make healthier food choices together.





LHWRF Honored with Excellence in CSR Award

We are honored to receive the Excellence in CSR (National) award from The Economic Times at the 5th Edition of the Healthcare Leaders Summit 2025. This recognition is a testament to our ongoing efforts to enrich lives by improving healthcare access, strengthening health systems, and empowering communities through sustainable livelihoods and economic opportunities.





Bringing heart health to communities this World Heart Day

We observed World Heart Day by organizing a series of activities across multiple locations to promote heart health. These included health camps, expert sessions on cardiovascular care, nutritional support for TB patients and malnourished children, women's sports competitions, and yoga sessions in villages reflecting our commitment to building healthier communities.





Workshop on Leadership and Team Management Skills

A two day "Leading & Managing Team" workshop was organised to build leadership and people management skills. Through experiential learning, role plays, creative exercises, and group discussions, participants reflected on their personal challenges in decision-making and team dynamics, while exploring effective negotiation tools. The sessions created a vibrant space for learning and exchange, encouraging participants to connect new insights with real workplace situations





Capacity Building Training for Frontline Healthcare Workers

Our Lives Program organised a three-day training program for ANMs and community mobilizers in Alwar, with 80 staff members participating. The training focused on strengthening capacities in three critical areas: communication, behavior change, and leadership development. In addition to technical skill-building, the sessions emphasized personal and professional growth, encouraging participants to adopt empathy-driven leadership, enhance personal management, and build stronger connections with community members.





Support to Flood Affected Communities in Jammu & Kashmir

Heavy rains and flash floods in Jammu & Kashmir have caused severe damage, displacing families and increasing the risk of waterborne diseases. In response, Lupin Ltd., in collaboration with CSIR-IIIM, supported essential medicines for emergency care and infection control. Additionally, LHWRF also supported with essential relief kits to 60 affected families, with staff volunteers ensuring timely delivery despite challenging conditions





Strengthening TB Care through Nutrition Support and Infrastructure Enhancement

As part of our ongoing efforts to fight TB, we launched a TB support project at our Jammu Centre to help 100 patients over the next six months. The project started by providing nutrition kits to 50 patients. These kits are designed to strengthen immunity and improve treatment outcomes, ensuring that patients receive sustained support until February 2026. Regular follow-ups and close engagement will help patients stay encouraged and committed to completing their treatment. The District Health Society, Samba recognized our efforts in supporting TB patients.

Additionally, to enhance TB care in Anakapalli District in Andhra Praadesh, 11 computers were provided to the District TB Control Office and 9 TB Control Units, improving service delivery, administration, and data management under the National TB Elimination Program, strengthening the district's TB elimination efforts.





Water-Efficient Irrigation Systems supported to Farmers

As part of the Water Resource Development for Livelihood Enhancement Project, implemented by LHWRP and supported by Whirlpool of India Ltd., drip and sprinkler irrigation systems were provided to 33 farmers in Kanhur Meshai village, Shirur block, Pune, Maharashtra, to promote water efficiency. The technical team offered guidance on efficient water use and the benefits of micro-irrigation systems.





Supporting Child Nutrition Monitoring in Ankleshwar, Gujarat

To support child health and nutrition, weighing scales were provided to 20 Anganwadi Centers in Ankleshwar block, Gujarat. This helps detect malnutrition early, ensuring healthier growth and better learning outcomes.





Employee Volunteers Bring Solar Lighting for Vulnerable Tribal Communities

As part of the Employee Volunteering Program, 16 employees visited 5 Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG) villages in Vizag and supported solar lights to 100 families facing electricity challenges. The volunteers discussed residents' difficulties, especially during the rainy season, and introduced solar lighting as a sustainable solution. This initiative addressed immediate lighting needs while promoting clean energy and improving quality of life for these vulnerable communities.





Fire Safety and WASH Training for Students

A Fire Safety Training was organized at Government Higher Secondary School, Sarakiya, Mandideep, where nearly 80 students participated in detailed classroom learning and live practical demonstrations by the safety team from Lupin Ltd. An engaging session on WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) and Nutrition was also conducted, led by WASH and nutrition experts, covering handwashing, sanitation, hygiene, health, and nutrition. These programs equip students with critical safety and hygiene skills, empowering them to protect themselves and promote healthier practices in their communities.





Upskilling Teams with Power BI Training

A Power BI training session was conducted across locations to enhance employees' data visualization and analytical capabilities. The session covered the full Power BI workflow from connecting to diverse data sources and transforming data using Power Query, to building effective data models with DAX and creating interactive dashboards and reports. Participants also explored Power BI Service features such as publishing, sharing, scheduled data refresh, and implementing Row-Level Security (RLS). This initiative empowers teams to leverage real-time insights for smarter, data-driven decision-making.





CPR Training at Pune Head Office

A CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) training session was conducted by Dr. Naresh Munot, DM – Cardiology for the staff at Pune Head Office. The session focused on equipping employees with essential life-saving skills, including recognizing emergencies, performing chest compressions, and providing rescue breaths, ensuring they are prepared to respond effectively in critical situations.
